The Darlington Junior Football Club – “The Bushrangers” - exists to promote the game of AFL Football and young people’s participation in football and sport in general; and to promote the education and involvement of coaches and umpires in junior football.

All of the club's main activity occurs at Darlington Oval, corner of Owen Road and Pine Terrace Darlington. The club's season commences on Registration day in late February. (Look out for the signs during February for the exact date!). Training commences three to four weeks before the first games in late April.



The DJFC caters for children aged between 5 (TO be able to register a child must turn five PRIOR to June 30 that year) and Twelve years old.

Five to eight year old children take part in Auskick on Saturday mornings (no training sessions during the week). In Auskick the focus is on fun, involvement and exercise... and skill development occurs as a by product! There is no travel; all of the activity takes place on Darlington Oval for a sixteen week season. Parents are encouraged

to assist in whatever way they are able and are expected to stay at the Oval for the 1 to 1 ½ hour session; OR arrange another parent to take responsibility for their child.



From nine years old and older we take part in an organised competition run by Swans District and based in the Hills. (We have catered for increasing numbers in recent years by also entering teams in the “Flats” competition; also under the Swan Districts banner) Teams in the Year Fours, Year Fives

and Twelves competitions train one night per week (usually Wednesday or Thursday night) and play on Sunday mornings. In these age groups there is no score kept and rules are modified according to age groups; with less restriction as the players get older.
