The Darlington Towards 2060 idea started in mid 2008 in response to a concern that the Village was not (then) thriving as its community might wish. This assumption was found to be only partially true. In fact, Darlington has very passionate views on its environment and an even stronger commitment to its preservation.

Following a workshop held in August, attended by 20 residents and a community meeting at the Hall in mid October 2009, attended by approximately 120 people, we concluded that there is support for development of a Strategic Plan for Darlington. This plan should look 50 years ahead, as this allows greater influence over our future than would be available in a 5 or 10 year plan.

Once agreed, the Strategic Plan will be given to DRRA, the Mundaring Shire, local Councillors, MPs, and interested parties. It becomes the plan that any future development is measured against as we head towards 2060.

We will hold a strategic planning workshop on 13/14 February 2010 to draft the Strategic Plan, and present it for discussion at a community meeting in the Hall on 4th March 2010. We will seek community endorsement of the Plan during March and April, in order to publish it by the end of May 2010.
